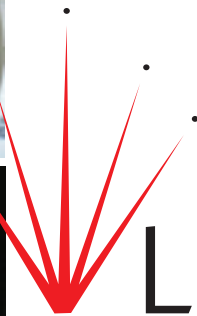

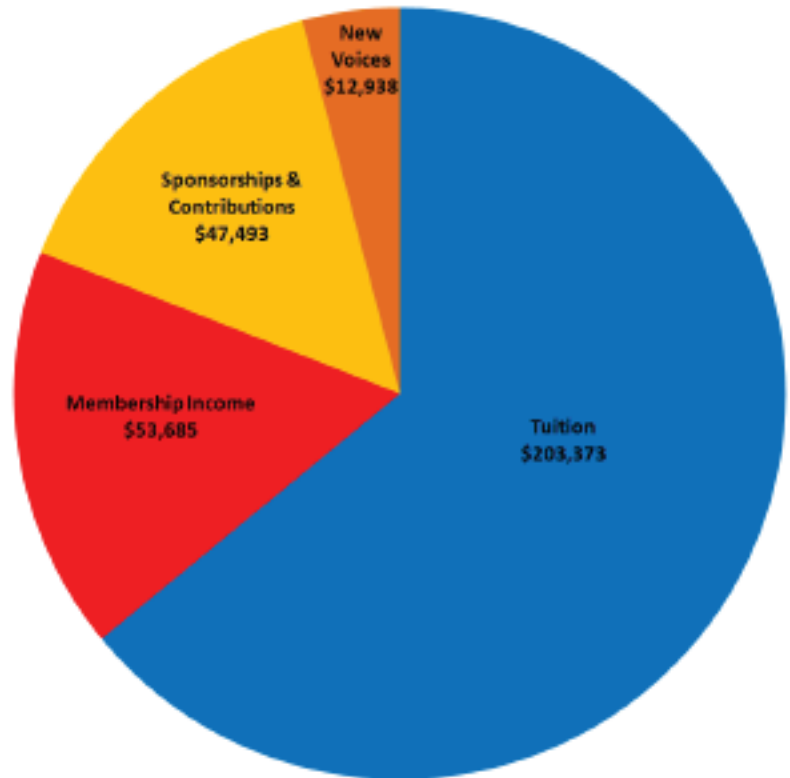

FINANCIAL RESULTS - STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES

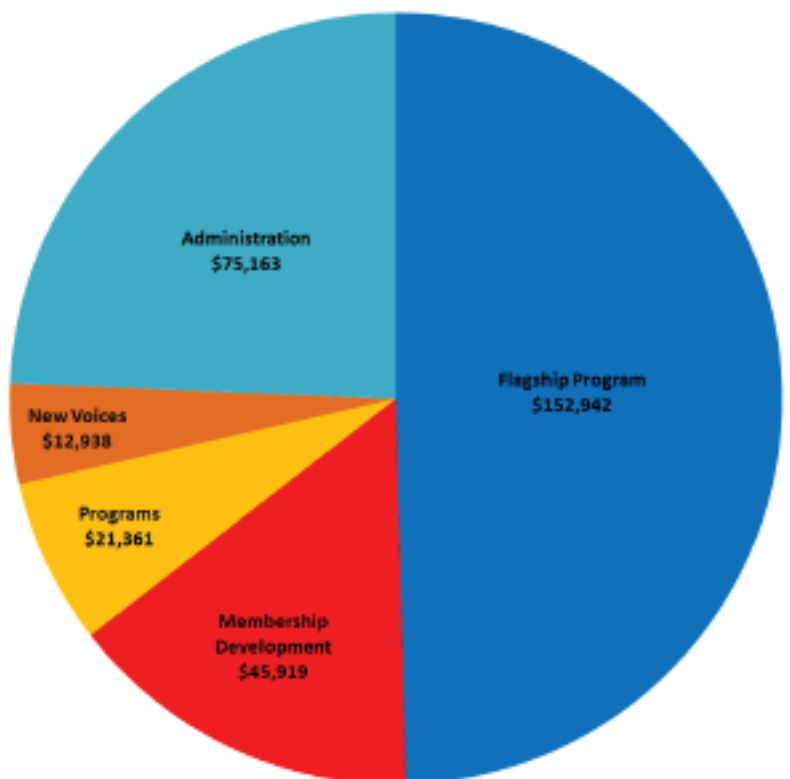
Year Ending June 30, 2010 (Audited)

NTDC CLASS 3

The North Tulsa Development Council (NTDC) is a result of the nTEDI four-month pilot leadership program created by Mayor Kathy Taylor in 2007. Participants of that pilot program came together to form NTDC and Class 1 was successfully implemented in the 2009-2010 year. Class 3 began in September of 2011 and is the second class under the Leadership Tulsa umbrella. The mission of the North Tulsa Development Council is to awaken leadership potential in community members to bring about economic development.

ABOUT LEADERSHIP TULSA

Leadership Tulsa has a nearly 40 year history of providing community leadership development programs. We were founded in 1973 as a joint project of the Tulsa Chamber of Commerce and the Junior League of Tulsa to help build the leadership capacities of Tulsa area professionals.

Our Flagship Program annually involves 90 adults representing a diverse cross-section of the community who learn about the infrastructure, needs and resources of Tulsa and how to get involved to effect positive change. Classes are chosen through a competitive selection process and participate in nine months of training and educational experiences focused on building leadership skills and understanding the community. In addition to their classroom learning experience, our participants give back to the community through service on area non-profit boards of directors. Once they have completed their program, participants become members of our organization and continue to give back through service. Our members serve on over 200 different boards and organizations, giving an average of 100 hours each, annually.

In recent years, Leadership Tulsa has expanded our community education offerings to take advantage of our key capabilities as an organization. We are partnering with the Tulsa Area United Way to help improve minority participation on non profit boards by identifying and training potential board members from under-represented populations through the **New Voices Board Internship Program**. We are also helping to train the next generation of community leaders through a strategic partnership with Typros, offering young professionals opportunities to receive board training and serve as board interns. Our partnership with the **North Tulsa Development Council** is bringing opportunities for leadership development and capacity building to this vital, but under appreciated part of our Tulsa community.
