As part of that event, we will be hosting a luncheon and afternoon workshop open to members of the Tulsa foundation and nonprofit community. Our guest speaker, Byron P. White, will introduce the Tulsa audience to Asset-Based Community Development (ABCD), a strategy for sustainable community-driven development.

Asset-Based Community Development was founded by John Kretzmann and John McKnight at Northwestern University. ABCD challenges community leaders to create opportunities for people instead of providing services. It is based on the premise that by identifying and mobilizing unrecognized or underutilized assets a community will drive its own change.

Byron P. White is a research associate at the Kettering Foundation, and serves on the Advisory Board of the E.W. Scripps School of Journalism at Ohio University and on the board of the Cleveland International Film Festival. He is an alumnus of leadership programs in Cincinnati, Cleveland and Chicago. He has a doctorate in higher education management from the University of Pennsylvania, a master's in social science from the University of Chicago and a bachelor's in journalism from the Honors Tutorial College at Ohio University. White is on faculty at the ABCD Institute at DePaul University.
