The traditional Leadership Tulsa program is a 360 degree exploration of Tulsa. Through a 10-month series of monthly meetings and a unique board internship experience, participants learn more about the history of Tulsa, become familiar with the opportunities and challenges facing our city, and develop a network to make a difference. Individuals applying for this program have gained success in personal or professional settings and desire the opportunity to build leadership skills and become more informed, connected and engaged in the larger Tulsa community.

Deadlines in April and October

Program Cost: \$2950 (scholarships available)



Thrive Tulsa is deep dive into individual leadership development for people who seek to learn and collaborate with others to make positive change in Tulsa. Participants meet twice monthly with their cohort to learn core skills for mobilizing people to make progress on complex community challenges. The cohort will develop ideas and explore collaborations for community impact projects, while creating a plan for their own development as a leader. Thrive Tulsa is open to those who work, live, or want to contribute to positive change in Tulsa.

Deadline in November

Program Cost: \$600 (scholarships available)



In partnership with the Greater Tulsa Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Hispanic Leadership Institute (HLI) convenes Hispanic/Latinx young professionals (generally ages 21 to 45) to explore leadership together. HLI allows individuals to develop and expand their knowledge, leadership skills and connections to take an active role in the community. HLI also offers participants the opportunity to engage with Tulsa's foremost business and policy authorities in a continuing dialogue about leadership and the civic sector. Ideal candidates are willing to learn and will be encouraged to give back to the Tulsa region through community involvement.

Deadline in July

Program Cost: \$600 (scholarships available)



Created in partnership with Oklahomans for Equality, LEAD Together is the only program in Oklahoma addressing LGBTQ leadership development. Over the course of six months, this program will strengthen your influence, build a valuable network, develop new models and mindsets for innovation using design thinking and build a strong network of LGBTQ peers with whom you can share ideas and experiences. Program is open to LGBTQ Individuals & Allies.

Deadline in November

Program Cost: \$400



In partnership with the Tulsa Area United Way, the New Voices Board Internship program is designed to increase diversity on Tulsa area boards. The year-long program includes an overnight retreat in September as well as monthly breakfast roundtable sessions with board mentors. Candidates will be from diverse racial, ethnic or religious backgrounds who have commitment to take on new leadership roles and expand their leadership skills.

Deadline in July

Program Cost: \$300 (scholarships available)



Tulsa Changemakers is a semester long, 25-session afterschool youth leadership development and action program that empowers elementary, middle, and high school students, from Title I schools in Tulsa Public Schools and Union Public Schools, to make meaningful change in their schools and communities. The program specializes in an asset-based and youth-driven approach to community impact. www.tulsachangemakers.org

Program Cost: Free



Seeking to prepare the next generation of community leaders through a strategic partnership with the Tulsa Chamber's Tulsa Young Professionals program, Get on Board offers young professionals opportunities to receive nonprofit board training and serve as board interns. Individuals interested apply to and are selected by the TYPros organization. Leadership Tulsa provides the board training and agency engagement.

Deadline in November

Program Cost: Free
